TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER

CONSIDERING THE APPLICATION AND SUPPORTING MATERIALS ATTACHED THERETO
FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER IN THE ABOVE:

The court finds that applicant has presented sufficient proof that immediate and irreparable harm will be suffered by applicant if this restraining order is not issued and therefore finds as follows:

IT IS ORDERED that this TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER be granted, herein directed to defendants, the American Association of Neurological Surgeons and Dr. Christopher Rumana and Dr. Mark Cuffe, preventing the AANS from instituting, reporting or in any way publishing the sanctions which it seeks to impose during the pendency of this case and until such time as the case can be heard, on the grounds that immediate and irreparable injury, loss, and damage will result to petitioner in light of the *prima facie* showing that he will prevail on the merits of the case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the preliminary injunction is set for hearing on July 19, 2006 and that applicant renew this TRO every ten (10) days until that date.
